



## St. Patrick's Weekend Action Plan

- All IFC members attending social events must wear a **BLUE** wristband. All PC members attending social events must wear a **PINK** wristband. Any guests of a member attending social events must wear a **YELLOW** wristband. Each chapter is responsible for purchasing these wristbands and distributing them to members. Failure to comply will result in a fine. Link to wristbands:
  - **IFC BLUE**
  - **PC PINK**
  - **GUEST YELLOW**
- For IFC, there must be **5 sober monitors**, and for PC there must be **4 sober monitors** for events equipped with contact information, sober monitor contracts and guest lists (chapter roster for IFC, hardcopy lists included guests for PC). Sober monitors must be present at the **entrance** of the event **from the registered start time to the conclusion of the event**. [Sober monitor contracts](#).
- All IFC sober monitors are required to wear **BLUE** bandanas. All PC sober monitors are required to wear **PINK** bandanas. These bandanas were delivered to PC and IFC Chapter Presidents from Martin Luther King Junior's Day. If a Chapter needs extra bandanas please contact the IFC EVP or PC VP Risk to request additional bandanas. Failure to comply will result in a fine.
- Any and all social events held in regards to St. Patrick's Day need to be registered!
- All fraternities are required to have snow fencing around their outside social premises.
